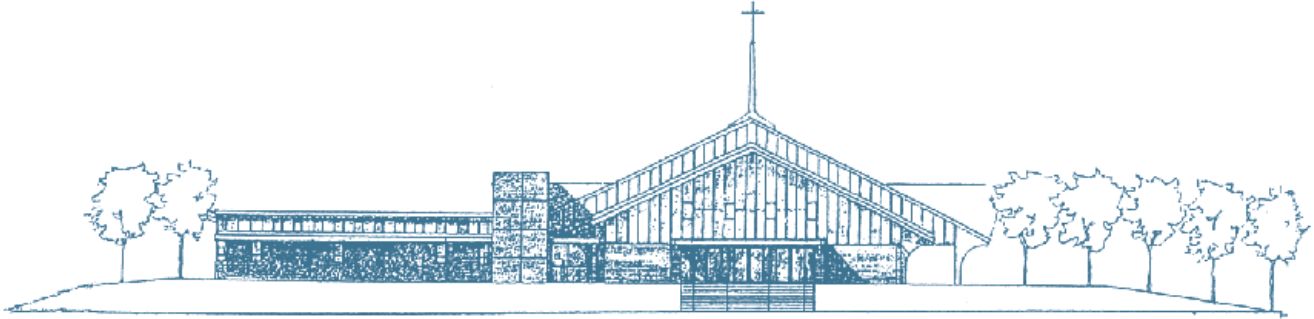

Dear Parishioners

You will find in this weekend's bulletin our Annual Financial Report for the Fiscal Year beginning July 1, 2010 and ending June 30, 2011. This report was reviewed and approved by our parish auditors, trustees and finance council and has been submitted to Bishop Tobin.

Once again, I am happy to report that our parish remains financially sound. Our weekly budget revenue is up 2% over last year despite this stubborn recession thanks to your inspiring generosity.

Our expenses were all in line with our budget except for our oil and snow removal costs, which were both substantially higher than expected due to the harsh winter. The subsidy to our school is again lower this year due to additional students and continued cost-cutting efforts. Looking to this year, I am concerned about the price of oil but expect all our other costs to remain about the same. Please note that I have set aside the funds from last year's Annual Collection for replacement of the gym floor. After consulting with flooring experts, I've decided to replace the floor rather than tile over it (it will last far longer this way). This will cost us much more than the original quote which means I need to keep saving for a few years. Thank you for your generous support of our Annual Collection which is allowing me to fund these larger projects.

Please note as well the payments being made on our parish loan from the diocese. Our outstanding loan is \$241,385. We will continue paying \$3,000 monthly from our budget collections until this loan is paid-off (hopefully by June, 2019).

My thanks to our business manager, Miss Eileen Papa, for preparing this report; our parish auditors, Mr. John Madoian and Mr. Matt Giarrusso, for reviewing this report; our parish trustees, Mr. Benjamin Butler and The Honorable Alice Gibney, and our Parish Finance Council (Deacon Noel Edsall, Mrs. Janice Olsen, Mr. Robert Flaherty, Mr. Frank Melucci and Mr. James Hagerty) for approving this report and all their on-going advice and support. And finally, my thanks to you, the generous people of our great parish! Without your prayers and sacrifices (I've noticed some people now tithing and many increasing their weekly giving), this parish would not be possible—and would not do all the amazing things it does throughout the year. Thank you for all your support—I'm honored to be your pastor! God bless you in the week ahead.

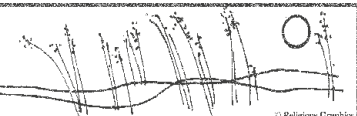
